Manage a caseload of six patients on a 44-bed unit that serves patients with complex nursing needs due to multiple comorbidities in addition to primary oncology diagnoses, such as pre and post bone marrow and stem cell recipients, patients in need of telemetry monitoring, and patients requiring contact precautions.

- Perform nursing assessments, review patient's medical records, and consult with physicians to develop, modify, and implement patient care plans. Initiate and participate in codes and rapid responses.
- Administer PO, IM, SQ, NGT, GTT, PRN, and IV medications, including narcotics, TPN, blood, and blood products, as well as oral chemotherapy, antibiotic therapy, and blood transfusions.
- Set up and maintain cardiac monitors as well as feeding, IV, and PCA pumps. Monitor and care for PIC lines, central lines, and chest tubes. Initiate and manage mediports and straight and Foley catheters.
- Implement wound care treatment plans, utilizing sterile techniques and infection control measures, for the treatment of post-surgical wounds and diabetic and pressure ulcers.
- Provide education to patients and family members with a focus on health promotion, medication management, device maintenance, and wound management.
- Prepare patients for discharge and follow up with pharmacy, transportation service, case managers, and social services staff to facilitate patients' transition.
- From November 2013 to present, assigned to the night shift. Developed a high level of skill in functioning independently, using critical thinking skills in a fast paced environment, to ensure quality patient care.
- From January 2013 to November 2013, assigned to the day shift. Collaborated with interdisciplinary team on discharge planning and learned advanced wound care techniques by observing the wound care team.
