- LTC and physical rehabilitation

- In-patient physical rehabilitation
  - 5 bed unit concentrating on the physical rehabilitation of patients who were medically stable but who needed more intensive therapy to recover their fullest potential.
  - Responsibilities included tracking patient progress through hand off reporting, therapy notes and observations. Adhering to the directives of the physical therapists for safe ambulation and intake. Emotional support and encouragement of the patients through this critical period. Assessment and observation of patients for any change in condition.
