As a nurse manager, supervision of the other floor nurses including CNA's, LPN's and other RN's are a part of these responsibilities. Arranging schedule conflicts to cover resident care for all nursing staff,

participating in on call supervisor rotation and aiding in ordering of supplies necessary for facility needs are other aspects used in this position.

Responsibilities of this position are also shared with the Director of Nursing, Assistant director of Nursing and the Administrator. Communication with the care team as a whole include two daily meetings to update all department heads on any new admissions, discharges or urgent matters concerned with the residents or facility.
