I worked in MICU in a 12 bed unit. The ratio was 2:1 . We were a Covid ICU in 2020 and that is still in effect for this year. We floated to SICU. I took care of Vent patients, Artic Sun patients, Peritoneal dialysis patients , DKA, Renal Failure with Dialysis in house, CHF patients, post Heart Cath Patients, Cardiac Ablation patients, Stroke , Aneurysm , Trach patients and much more. The unit started doing Sleds patients. We did occasional Balloon Pumps and other. We dealt with Art lines , different drips

like Dopamine, Dobutamine, Lasix, Potassium, Minoxidil, Propofol, Fentanyl, Ativan, Precedex etc. We housed trach to vent patients as well. It was a busy unit but fun unit a lot of the time because we worked as a team. We also were responsible for CODES and RRT along with SICU.
