SKSH has a 246 bed capacity for the care of inpatients, and a number of outpatient clinics open during the week. A walk-in-service for people with minor illnesses and injuries is currently open to the public and expected to open fully as an Emergency Department in August 2015. **Hospital Description**

The Philippine Heart Center (PHC) is seated on a 2.7 hectare lot at the corner of East Avenue and Matalino Street in the Diliman District of Quezon City. It is bounded by the East Avenue Medical Center on its side. The PHC hospital proper is a 354-bed tertiary care center. There are twenty-one nursing units, including 53 Intensive Care Unit (ICU) bed, 24 suites, 56 private rooms, a presidential suite, 74 semi-private rooms, 3 adult service wards, and a pediatric service ward. Its Design having 4 petals in each floor represents the 4 chambers of the human heart.

The Philippine Heart Center is essentially a hospital for patients suffering from heart ailments. However, it is equipped to render the best possible care for most other illnesses. It ranks as one of the leading medical institutions in Asia for the medical and surgical management of heart diseases. The center admits more than 12,00 patients yearly, of whom more than 2,500 undergo heart surgery. Aside from offering medical services, the center is deeply involved in cardiovascular research, training and education and public information. It offers training programs not only for aspiring heart specialists but also for private and government medical practitioners. It engages in various researches on the prevention and control of cardiovascular diseases and undertakes nationwide information programs on the heart and heart care.
