

- » Worked in the Stepdown ICU unit with high acuity patients, including post-op open hearts, post VATs, post cardiac cath, postop Watchman, and Level 1 traumas, as well as tracheostomyventilator dependent patients.
- » Responsible for the care of other critically ill patients, including alcohol withdrawal, drug overdose, septic shock, respiratory failure, and medically declining patients needing emergent dialysis.
- » Provided care and continuous monitoring for patients on non-titratable cardiac drips and for patients with ordered neurological checks every 2 hours.
- » Cared for COVID patients who needed to be on continuous BiPap, on the maximum oxygen setting. Monitored these patients closely due to high likelihood for intubation.
- » During the initial COVID surge, was cross-trained as an ICU nurse to take care of intubated patients who were sedated, paralyzed, and routinely proned. Trained to administer paralytics, analgesics, and sedating IV medications to COVID patients.
