- Plan and collaborate discharge with multidisciplinary team (social worker, physician, case manager, dietitian, wound care team, nurse assistant, chaplain, physical therapy, respiratory therapist).
- Preceptor of new nurses, nursing students, nursing assistant, nominated employee of the month.
