Communicated patient condition and treatment plans to patient and families, gaining consents as required. Performed phlebotomy, intravenous insertion and interpreted laboratory results. Stabilized critically ill patients and collaborated with ICU nurse and doctors for transfer of care. Stabilized trauma and transferred patients as need for specialized care.
