- Triage patients of 18 weeks gestation and beyond in 6 bed bay into levels of acuity based on thorough assessment and communication with providers
- Proficient in interpreting fetal monitoring and appropriate interventions
- Provide safe, quality, and culturally competent care to both high and low risk labor patients
- Perform sterile vaginal exams, assessment of patient throughout progression of labor
- Assist in vaginal and cesarian deliveries, responsible for maintaining patient safety of both mother and newborn

- Incorporate “spinning babies” techniques for patients in prolonged first and second stage of labor
