As the primary nurse it's important we provide a detailed amount of education and support to our transplant recipients/ donors and their families throughout this journey. Undergoing transplant is an emotional process physically and mentally on the patient, it's imperative as the primary nurse we support and fully educate our patients from the moment of admission to discharge
