Assess, triage and admit antepartum, laboring, preterm, PIH, inductions, placenta previa, placental abruptions, delivering, surgical pre-op for scheduled cesarean sections, and or emergency cesarean sections, and circulate in the OR. Recover cesarean sections in PACU, recover labor patients after SVD. Manage patients on MgSO4, antibiotics, tocolytics, perform ACCU checks for GDM, administer labetalol protocol in antepartum and postpartum if necessary. Computer documentation in

CPN and Meditech, monitor EFM, FSE, TOCO, or IUPC. Set up, prep and assist with delivery, epidural, spinal, and set PCA pump as needed. Anticipate, notify provider of delivery of infant, call NICU if NB is under 35 weeks gestation. Provide postpartum recovery care teaching, monitor patients' vital signs and fundal checks for postpartum hemorrhage, help latch NB and encourage skin to skin and breast feeding.
