IV initiation, maintenance and discontinuation, set up and use of IV pumps and brains, head to toe assessments, recognition of cardinal signs of patient decompensation, advanced airway care of ventilators and tracheostomies, documentation of care, communicating with physicians, postoperative nursing care including orthopedics, GI/GU, cardiac and pulmonary, effective communication with support staff, admitting and discharging patients, prioritization of patient care needs, patient care plans, patient teaching, telemetry monitoring, understanding cardiac rhythms, catheter insertions, wound care, injections, tube feed, sterile technique, use of evidence based practice, enema administration, and gathering of laboratory samples such as urine, sputum, and blood. In addition to these skills,

I was a part of code blue situations where ACLS measures were implemented and I was able to gain an understanding of my role, and how to work effectively with a team in a critical situation.
