  - Administers medications orally, intravenously, intramuscular, PICC line, and G-tube.
  - Assesses and provides care for patients with tracheostomies and g-tubes.
  - Performs venous blood draws, blood draws from port a Cath, PICC line, and midline.
  - Documents patient progression from admission to discharge, and updates plan of care as needed in Epic.
  - Educates the patient and family on medications, diagnosis, and plan of care.
  - Follows infection control policies, including sepsis protocol and procedures.
- Maintains knowledge of all current policies.
- Performs neurological and NIH stroke scale assessments.
