checks patient's cervix periodically to monitor progression/lack of dilation, ensures patient's bed is kept dry & clean; cleans up bodily fluids expelled before & after the birthing process contacts anesthesia when/if patient is ready for epidural; contacts delivering physician at appropriate time, ascertains proper time, cares for patients on Pitocin, MgSO4 & continuous lumbar epidural, ensures patient is in proper position for delivery & all monitoring equipment is functioning properly, aids doctor with drapes, gloves, gowns, etc.; hands doctor delivery instruments as needed during birthing process, encourages patient to push at proper time(s) records time of birth, immediate care of newborn (clean, weigh, etc.) gives Apgar scores, prepare mother and newborn for transport to mother baby unit for postpartum care.
