I was a nursery nurse. I would help with infant care after delivery or Ceserean Sections (dry and stimulate the baby, suction and suction the stomach if needed d/t mechonium or fluid absorption not happening fast enough.) Would Assess infant and monitor for temperature, or any abnormalities that might be seen after the delivery. Would help mother and baby bonding and how to breast feed with continuous monitoring of the baby depending on the severity. I have placed IV's and transferred infants to Level 1 hospital for better montioring (Niswonger or Children's Hospital in Knoxville.)
