- Triage incoming patients base on acuity level of injury or illness, immediately stabilize patients as needed
- Start intravenous lines, and collect laboratory samples, including urinalysis, throat cultures, wound cultures and nasal swabs
- Manage team of 3-6 patients at a time with an EMT, efficiently prioritize care of all patients and delegate tasks when able
- Collaborate with physicians, nurses, EMT's, surgeons and other hospital personnel as necessary to provide quality patient care
- Provide IV sedation along with MD and respiratory therapy for cardioversions, reductions, laceration repair, etc and monitor patients post sedation until medically stable
- Critical thinking, problem solving and teamwork
- Maintain calm demeanour during stressful busy situations
- Patient and family advocate; provide education upon admission and discharge

- Communicate any abnormal test results, symptoms or changes in patients condition to Surgeons, Anesthesiologists and or CRNA's
- Provided post anesthesia care to patients ranging from 8 months to geriatric
