It is my duty to monitor trends in patient condition and intervene as necessary. I worked on this floor as a staff nurse for a year before I was promoted to charge nurse. In this role, I was expected to assist the floor nurses when needed, overlook their charting and patient care, do patient education, assist in resolving disputes with patients and family members, and reporting necessary information or results to the attending physicians. After over three years in this role, I accepted a position in the ICU, where I performed essentially the same tasks as I did as a floor nurse in the medical surgical unit with the addition of conscious sedation and titrating IV medications. I worked in this position for a little over a year.
