Additional Information

I managed a satellite chronic interventional pain clinic for 6 years. I was the procedure nurse that assisted the physician with sterile procedures including epidural steroid injections, sacroiliac joint injections, spinal cord stimulator trials, intrathecal pain pump trials and numerous other procedures. I ran the fluoroscopy C-arm and ultrasound. I performed sterile procedures myself including bandage changes, IM/IV injections, administered conscious sedation as well as intrathecal pain pump refills regularly under the physicians supervision. Addressed patients concerns via phone, computer and in person. I overlooked/managed the receptionist and LPN staff. I often took calls after work hours, participated in regular weekly, monthly, quarterly meetings. I ordered all inventory for the Burlington and Davenport locations as well as some of the nearby surrounding community health centers.
