## Additional Information

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Served as an Investigative Nurse making daily reports to the DIA for physical abuse allegations and unknown etiology of bruises, skin tears, falls and allegations of sexual abuse. Researching patients care management and MDS status was vital in this position to establish if current care was to the benefit of the patient. Overseeing medications and possible side effects was key to this position as it would effect probable cause of injury or changed behaviors. Assessing the living environment of the resident was reviewed to assure furniture, alarms, bedframes, bathrooms and floors were kept in an acceptable status for residents safety. After final assessment of investigation I often had to update MDS and care management information to match residents most current needs.
