This was one of the more constructive jobs I've had mentally, not in the typical context. It had many physical challenges and mental obstacles.

When I started at Hughes, they told me I would be driving a boom truck. Unfortunately, I didn't have my CDL. They used me for yard work and driving 80% of the time. When it was slow, I would study or drive to the DMV. 1 month later I got my B class CDL. Once I became licensed, they used me in the boom truck to deliver all the frame packs for houses. I also set beams, plywood and other various objects in calculated places. That's generally what my job consisted of other than a little bit of management. there was a lot of undercover counseling and motivation for my coworkers as well... I had to deal with a couple of conflicts involving my colleagues. At first it was a challenge to gain everyone's respect. I realize if I could stoop to everyone else's level and pick up trash and do the grunt work around the yard it would not only gain everyone's respect but also be influencing them to make productive choices. I liked working for this company, but the hours were painful and so was dealing with management. They were extremely unprofessional with customers and their employees, it bothered me. I see difficulty as an opportunity for growth to a point. However, sometimes a group of people can be too much for one person. So, I enjoyed the labor for what it was worth.

### Rogue jet boat work

Oct 10-Feb19 of 2020-2021

I started in the trailer shop. I was Welding and fabricating aluminum trailers from scratch. Curtis guided me through the basics like how to use a bandsaw to cut or bevel edges. I use a MIG and a TIG welder. then I got transferred to the Rigging department. That's where I was taught how to do wiring, carpeting, working and a lot of basic motor tech skills. The owner would occasionally have me run errands like change tires, get propane dump scrap or pick up wiring adapters. I like to stay positive and calm always even if there are people that are extremely hard to tolerate. Working with metals, creating or installing high quality parts and pieces is my ideal source of income.
