## **Skills and Abilities**

- Monitor and set-up CVP and ART lines with addition to caring for post cardiac patients that have stents placed, clots removed, pacemakers, or balloon- pumps/ impella devices implanted. Provided treatment with assessment skills to patients with Heart Failure, Pulmonary Emboli, Respiratory Distress/Failure, Glycemic Imbalances, Cardiac Arrest
- Care for patient that are very critical, such as CVA, stroke, DKA, post surgeries with complications, hypertensive crisis and patient's survival outcome depends on ACLs medication and critical care interventions.
- As an ICU nurse I have become knowledgeable in titrating drips, postmortem care, educating and teaching patient and family about the care being provided and needed compliance from patient and family during hospital and discharge to promote a healthy and positive outcome of care.
- Therapeutic therapy and care with patients that have artificial airways on mechanical ventilators, continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP) ventilation such as bilevel noninvasive positive airway pressure (BIPAP), and oxygen therapy devices, trouble shooting and cleaning medical devices, patient care, and monitoring patient with different skin problems, wounds, and post-surgical incisions.
- A clinical supervisor manages the patient's POC, and medication orders prescribed by a physician or NP, provided education to healthcare professionals concerning competencies and skill advancement. Resume patient care after an acute episode either through ROC, SOC, or OASIS. Perform recertification or supervisory visits every 14 to 60 days as required by the state. Delegate patient care with nurses, aides, and physicians to provide care coordination and continuum of care. Perform initial health assessment and POC to deliver optimal health outcomes and goals.
- Implemented service and care to neonates and adults in respiratory distress needed medical attention, or routine care.
- Maintain a positive work environment. Work well in conjunction with Administrative Head and other Facility administration. Drawing and analyzing ABGs and CBGs, administering curosurf,(Surfactant) assist in umbilical venous catheters and umbilical arterial catheters line placements, and placing patients on vents, and other resp. equipment to ensure adequate treatment involving resp. care. Caring for patients in Trauma, ICU, Burn Center, and ER
- Served as a department educator in promoting effective patient care services, ensure equipment was safe and reliable, target hospital's objectives, and demonstrated motivate leadership for the hospital staff.
- ensure that hospital equipment's work efficient and accordance and appropriate to healthcare standards, such as HIPPA regulations, protocols, procedure manual.

- Caring for neonates less than 36 weeks of gestation that requires resuscitation, and life support. Give meds that improve life expectancy. Associate of a resuscitate team that provides care to patient displays compromise health. Give breathing treatment to adults and neonates and maintained and treat patients who have artificial airways.

- Consults specific physicians for specific medical problems, assessments, evaluations, and pre/post care surgery. Placing doctor's orders and making sure they are correctly read back and administered correctly. Consult pharmacy for missed meds, or reactions to meds, or meds needed in resuscitation situation. Consult PT, Speech therapy, OT, Wound care, and Nutrition to provide and multidisciplinary care to the patients that are in my care to promote a positive and healthy outcome.

Educated hospital staffs about safe handling of Respiratory equipment and the proper uses. I have precept respiratory students about therapeutic care of patient in respiratory distress and/or arrest; such as intubation, resuscitation, ABG analysis, Art line management and access, and oxygen therapy
