Manage and administer prescription medications as prescribe, could include monthly or weekly medication setup. Responsible to manage bedridden patient's for bed sores and muscle weakness at each visit. Writing and sending reports about each visit to the patient's physician. I identify care issues and make recommendations about changes to the patient's care plan.

Talking to family member's, and caregiver's who are present during my visits and listens to their concerns and update them on the patient's condition.

Educate patients and their families on proper home health care strategies and procedures.
