July 2022 to Present

- Care of infirm neonates, newborns, and toddlers in NICU (get floated to PICU and CCU as needed).
- Start IV's, place NG/OG tubes, aid Physicians and NNP's in bedside line placements, lumbar punctures, and specimen withdrawal.
- Assess and maintain the health of post-op infants, perform dressing changes, and ensure the safety and health of children receiving blood products and various medications.
- Prepare infants for surgeries, transport them to tests (EEG, MRI, Ultrasound).
- Prepare breast milk and fortify breast milk as ordered.
- Care for patients in need of surgical intervention (Lurie's is a surgical NICU and surgeons conduct neurological, cardiac, pulmonary, urinary, renal, musculoskeletal, and transplant surgeries as medically required).

- Care of neonates in NICU or step-down.
- Perform line changes, place peripheral IV's, assist in central line placement.
- Care for patients on ventilators (regular and high-frequency ventilators such as oscillators or jets).
- Care for patients on CPAP, Bi Pap, high-flow nasal cannula, and nasal cannula.
- Assist with bedside procedures (line placements, lumbar punctures, X-RAY positioning).
- Set up and maintain prophylactic phototherapy.
- Weigh, bathe, measure, and change infants throughout course of shift.
- Receive admissions.

NICU RN (PRN)

- Care for critically ill and premature neonates with (and without) genetic anomalies.
- Take vital signs every 1-4 hours as ordered and as needed.
- Lab draws (heel sticks, peripheral, arterial, umbilical, lumbar puncture).
- Assist with bedside procedures (line placements, lumbar punctures, bowel irrigation).
- Place peripheral IV's.
- Prepare neonates for surgery, receive them from surgery.

- Care for patients on ventilators (regular and high frequency such as oscillator and jet ventilators).
- Place feeding tubes (NG/OG) as needed with and without suction, perform gastric decompression and feed as ordered and as tolerated.

- Care for critically ill premature and term infants.
- Place NG/OG tubes as needed.
- Start IV's, aid in bedside procedures such as chest tube placement, Broviac, and PICC line insertions, intubation, medication administration.
- Take hourly vital signs; assess infants every 1-4 hours as ordered.
- Support parents in providing kangaroo care to premature infants.
- Feed, bathe, and change patients as needed throughout 12 hour shifts.
- Work with premature infants in giraffe radiant warmers, isolettes, and cribs.
- Transport patients to surgery with surgical team and respiratory therapists.

- Triage patients and work them up for MD's to work on (take vitals, enter information into MAR).
- Dispense medication to sedate patients prior to procedures as ordered.

Work with interdisciplinary care team to coordinate safe and effective patient care, complete assessments throughout shift with vital signs and glucose checks, complete Med-passes, place NG tubes, Foley catheters, and straight catheterizations as ordered. Assess and measure wounds, output from drains (JP, penrose, wound VAC's, hemovac's), and complete dressing changes as ordered and needed throughout shift. Start IV's, change -ostomy appliances as needed, place flexi-seals and rectal tubes, and assist in placement of chest tubes and assessments of chest tube drainage.
