I oversee the payroll and scheduling of CMTs that work for me while ensuring that the ordering of supplies and medications are complete. Also, I perform daily checks on all sharps in the facility to ensure safety is upheld. I ensure all the inmates are on the proper medication and their health and mental needs are met. I work closely daily with providers in maintaining safe recovery of opioid, benzo, alcohol and other detox processes. I oversee the behavioral health department and make sure they are in compliance with meetings and psychology appointments. I also administer and assess for MAT (medication assisted treatment) needs as well to ensure the inmates safe return to their home after incarceration.
