Duties include preparing dialysis machines and equipment for treatments. Initiate treatments by cannulating vascular accesses or use of hemodialysis catheter. Assess vital signs prior, during, and after treatment. Perform dressing changes and lab draws along with necessary daily cleaning and stocking responsibilities.

Acute care team responsibilities consist of inpatient dialysis treatment in a hospital setting. Hospitals include Pro healthcare in Waukesha and Oconomowoc. Pro healthcare rehabilitation center, and Lifecare Hospital. Duties include obtaining orders from MD, monitoring lab values, monitoring and charting vital signs, drawing labs, administering necessary medications, obtaining blood cultures, and administering blood transfusions when necessary.
