General responsibilities for these departments include, respectively, performing preoperative and postoperative patient care to include transcribing Physician orders for specimens, tests and medications needed prior to and Day of Surgery, as well as collection and conduction of said specimens and tests, to include blood, urine, EKG and X-rays as needed.

On Day of Surgery, duties include patient preparation for procedure, IV starts, education as needed for patient and family, verifying all consents have been signed and witnessed, and coordinating with Physician, patient, and staff regarding operative plan of care. Upon arrival to PACU, duties include full head to toe assessment of patient, including thorough assessment operative site and/or potential complications from operation. Monitoring of patient after surgery routinely includes cardiac, respiratory and oxygenation status, as well as pain and nausea management. Set up of cardiac monitors, oxygen delivery systems, arterial lines, chest tubes, suction devices, pulse oximeters, hypothermic devices, and defibrillators as needed is standard operating procedures. Pain and nausea management is routinely monitoring and controlled with IV medications, requiring close monitoring of post-op patients.

Other routine duties not directly related to patient care include Charge Nurse duties, including supervision of and assistance to other staff members; serving as a facilitator to mediate complaints or concerns from patients, family members and other staff members, collaboration with an interdisciplinary team to develop and implement strategies to promote health and improve patient care. In addition, charge nurse or experienced nurses will often serve as mentors to newly hired staff or nursing students, or delegate this task to other nurses as deemed suitable.
